Dear Families,

Due to the extreme weather conditions forecast for this week, we have made the following decisions to help ensure the safety and wellbeing of our pupils:

**Tuesday 23 June – School will remain open**

**Wednesday 24 June – School will be closed**

**Thursday 25 June – School will be closed**

**Friday 26 June – We will continue to monitor the situation and will confirm our decision regarding opening by Wednesday.**

We strongly recommend that if your child has a medical condition that may be affected by high temperatures, or if they are likely to become significantly dysregulated in the heat, you consider keeping them at home on Tuesday.

If your child will not be attending school on Tuesday due to the high temperatures, please contact the school reception by 8am, to inform us of their absence or complete the [Absence Form](#) on our website.

If your child attends school on Tuesday and we feel that they are struggling to cope with the heat, we may contact you and ask that they are collected early. Please ensure that a parent, carer, or emergency contact is available and can be reached throughout the day.

We recognise that this may create challenges for some families, however, given the forecast temperatures and the limitations of our school buildings in maintaining safe and comfortable learning environments during extreme heat we believe this is the most appropriate course of action.

Thank you for your understanding and support as we prioritise the health and safety of our school community.
